### History

The main branch of the school was established in April 1992 by Mr. R.P. Singh. It is located in Vishal Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow. Its Vinamra Khand Branch was established in April 2004.

### Rules of Admission

- a) Admission to Class Pre. Nur.: Students of age 3 years or more are considered for admission. There is no entrance tests for this class. Admissions are only on the basis of interviews.
- b) Admission to Class Nur. to IX: Students who have attended recognized schools are considered for admission. Admissions are normally made in March on the basis of entrance tests and interviews.
- c) Admission to Class XI: All admissions to class XI are provisional until the results of the class X Board Examinations are declared. Any student who fails to obtain a pass certificate in the class X Board Examination will have to be withdrawn immediately.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

Class I to VIII: Grey Tunic/Skirt, Light Pink Shirt, Black shoes, Socks with Pink strips, School Tie and Belt.

Class IX to XII: Light Pink Kameez (as per approved pattern), White Salwar with white Dupatta.

### Sports Uniform :-
